<p>Facilitation of the relevant objectives <small>How this proposal will, if implemented, better facilitate the “code relevant objectives”, as defined in Condition 9 of the Gas Transporters Licence.</small></p> <p>Since the alignment of iGT processes, where possible, is highly desirable for both Shipper/Supplier as evidenced by the historical joint approach to the development of this format, this modification will further the relative objectives of the Gas Transporters standard licence condition 9 by securing effective competition between relevant shippers and between relevant suppliers using a common approach to the transfer of industry data.</p>	
<p>Additional Information and Comments</p> <p>The use of this format has long been seen as a key mechanism to the provision of industry portfolio data. Shippers are keen to see its introduction in a standardised way to improve its use in their businesses while iGTs see the benefits in the shipper/supplier’s use of portfolio data to reduce their need to resource a telephone enquiry service to manage shipper/supplier enquiries to provide data contained within the extract.</p>
