<p><b>Facilitation of the relevant objectives</b></p> <p>RWE Npower support the proposer's belief that this will facilitate the effective competition between relevant Shippers and between relevant Suppliers as it will help to ensure that more meter reads are used in the calculation and reconciliation of gas consumption ensuring correct allocation of costs between Shippers/Suppliers.</p>	
<p><b>Additional Information and Comments</b></p> <p>RWE Npower supports the implementation of this modification proposal as it will allow more "actual" reads to be used during the AQ Review process which will improve the accuracy of the AQ's for the following gas year.</p> <p>We also support the move to align the iGT UNC rules with that of the Large Transporter's UNC as it will give Shippers the opportunity to integrate the management of processing and validation of meter reads into one system/process.</p>
