For the purposes of this Clause 20 the provisions of paragraph 4.4 of Section G of the UNC shall apply with the following changes:

Paragraphs 4.4.3(a)(ii), 4.4.3(b)(ii), 4.4.4(b), 4.4.5(c)(ii) and 4.4.10(a)(ii) shall not apply.

the words "and Energy Balancing Charges" shall be removed from paragraph 4.4.6(c) paragraph 4.4.6(d) shall not apply.

21. Vacant Sites

21.1 Interpretation

For the purposes of the Code:

The "Vacant Site Guidance Document" is the document established, specified under TPD Section V12.1 (g) of the UNC and maintained in TPD Section V12 of the UNC.

21.2 For the purposes of this Clause 21.2 the provisions of TPD Section G10 of the UNC shall apply with the following changes:

The reference to H2 in paragraph 10.2.3 (a) shall be interpreted as a reference to H2 but only to the extent that it applies to the calculation of NDM Supply Meter Point Demand pursuant to Part F of this Code.

The reference to M5.9 shall be interpreted as a reference to M5.9 but only to the extent that it applies in Part E Clause 10 of this Code.

The reference to M5.10 shall be interpreted as a reference to M5.10 but only to the extent that it applies in Part E Clause 11 of this Code.

New Definition to be added to Part M:

"Vacant Site Guidance Document" is the document established, specified under TPD Section V12.1 (g) of the UNC and maintained in TPD Section V12 of the UNC.

Commentary:

Amendments to UNC TPD Section G paragraphs 2.3.21, 2.3.22 and 2.3.27 will be applicable to the IGT UNC as the 3 paragraphs are referenced in Part CI Section 6 Annual Quantity.

New drafting to be added to reference new paragraph 10 in TPD Section G of the UNC. See above.

New definition added for the "Vacant Site Guidance Document" acknowledging its maintenance under the UNC.

References to TPD Section H2, Section M5.9 and 5.10 in the UNC drafting have been made applicable by reference to their application in the IGT UNC.
